4)	Report from Fabric Committee (English Martyrs) Father Paul reported: We are still waiting on an electrician for the work on the fans to be done and that the diocese would need to be consulted regarding the addition of the conservatory to the back of English Martyrs church.	
5)	Report from Fabric Committee (SWF) Jackie Reported: Roof: Currently Woodham Windows are replacing the soffits and fascia boards on the Church. The cost of this is £7,100. Once this is completed M D Roofing will then replace the four lower gutters. These will be coated with Triflex and Smart Water products. When this is finished the lower roof will be treated with anti-climb paint. The entire cost will be approx £10,000.

7)	<p>Report from Treasurer:</p> <p>As at today our current account is £18,168 in credit.</p> <p>Over July and August there were the normal expenditures, with the largest amounts going on Diocesan quotas (£1200 per month) and £2272 on a cheque to Father Paul for car, salary, housekeeping etc.</p> <p>NB We have contributed just under a £1000 to the Papal visit.</p> <p>Our income was down £1,000 for July and August combined, when compared to last year and so far this year is £2,000 on the same point last year.</p> <p>Up and coming known expenditure are the JCC quota (£1200) in September.</p> <p>But overall the accounts look healthy and we still have money to invest..</p>
